2. The duration of Short Service Commission is 10 years, extendable to 14 years.

3. The training of officers selected through the above entries normally commences in the month of Jan/Jul every year. Advertisement calling for application from eligible candidates are published in Employment News and important Newspaper in April/May and Sep. to Nov. The selection procedure includes UPSC

examination (for NDA, 10+2 (Ex) and GS Entry), interview at Services Selection Board and Medical Examination.
